

OWEN AND DASH AND



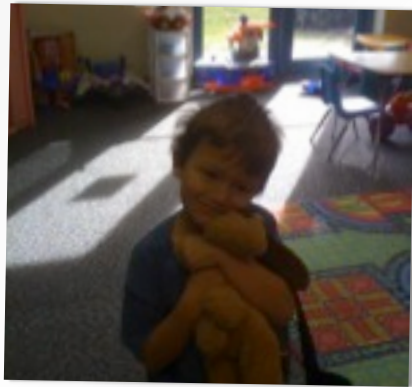

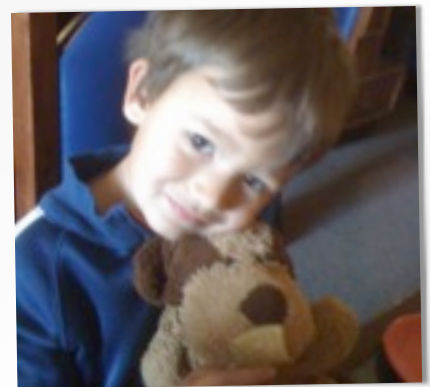
